

Iron on instructions

CottonTrends Iron-On Labels are easy to apply. Just follow these step by step instructions. These instructions are also included in every ordered package.

1. Set iron on Cotton. Allow your iron to heat up. Do not steam.
2. Put the piece of clothing on the ironing table.
3. Place the label on the garment in desired position.
4. Cover the label with the enclosed bakery release paper. Use a thin pressing cloth on delicate fabrics.
5. Firmly press heated iron on label covered with bakery paper for 15-17 seconds. DO NOT hover over the label.
6. Allow garment and label to cool to room temperature. Then try to peel off the label off with your fingernail. If the label comes off at the corners, repeat step 4-6.



Iron-on labels:

- Do not exceed ironing instructions of clothing care label of the garment itself.
- Apply labels to clean, dry garments only. Labels applied to damp garments or garments treated with fabric softener may not adhere properly. If the garment is damp, then iron it dry before applying the labels.
- On difficult fabrics a better result may be achieved by fixing the label to an existing label on the garment.
- Consider fitting labels on the care instruction label of your garments case you want to remove the label once your child grows out of the clothing or when you wish to give your clothing to someone else.
- Iron around the label when ironing the garment.
- Keep unused labels out of reach of children



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
